The East Lansing Community Baseball Camp will offer participants at all levels a challenging and rewarding experience that will help them gain an understanding of teamwork and sportsmanship; learn the game of baseball; and develop age-appropriate skills—in a safe, positive, nurturing environment. All of the camps are held at the East Lansing Softball/Baseball Complex.

Campers entering grades 1-4 and 5-9 will learn the rules, fundamentals and age-appropriate skills with group and individual instruction. Morning sessions will be filled first and afternoon sessions will be added, if needed.

The Camp is designed to challenge players to build on their skills -- providing group and individual instruction. Team and individual competitions will be held.

The Camp staff will feature former college players Jeremy Nordquist (EMU), Shane Johnson (MSU), Ryan Jones (MSU and San Francisco Giants organization), East Lansing high school coaches, current varsity players and alumni, and other community coaches. We will also have other special guest instructors and speakers, including players from the Lansing Lugnuts.
